MAHTA’s mission is to bring unity and continuity to the Animal Health Technologist profession. As a recognized organization, MAHTA will strive to keep up high standards, move forward as a profession, and promote growth through our continued education. This statement is backed by MAHTA’s bylaw (4.3) which states: “A member must complete a minimum requirement of continuing education credits each year to maintain registered membership.” The minimum requirement of continuing education credits is **10 credit hours** per membership year.

These credits can be obtained as follows:

- **Seminars** - 1 credit / speaker hour. This includes lunchtime seminars, conferences, wetlabs and workshops as approved by MAHTA, MVMA, other provincial association seminars and any large North American conferences that are pre-approved for credit.
- **Transcripts from MAHTA Seminars** - ½ number of specified credits to a maximum of 3 CE credits per year.
- **Public Speaking Engagements** - 1 credit / speaker hour. Must be educational and promote the AHT field
- **Published Articles** - 2 credits / article. The article must be published in the MAHTA newsletter or any other publication approved by MAHTA.
- **Published Articles with Quiz** - 3 credits / article with quiz. The article must be published in the MAHTA newsletter or any other publication approved by MAHTA.
- **Registry of Approved Continuing Education (RACE)** - Any Veterinary RACE approved seminar, conference or online course.
- **CE Quizzes** – 1/2 credit per quiz or as designated by publication. This applies to quizzes submitted from Vet Tech magazine, CALAS National Newsletter, MAHTA Newsletter, or any other source approved by MAHTA.
- **Computer on-line or various media outlets** - however many number of credits deemed fair. This may be obtained through webinar, video or audio and must be verified by examination.
- **Workshops/Seminars** - A maximum of 3 CE credits may be claimed indirectly related to animal health and welfare. (Eg: management/accounting courses)

If you are unsure of credit value of a seminar or have questions about CE’s please contact your MAHTA office by email at MAHTA@mts.net or by phone at 204-832-1394.

NOTE: Proof of completion (certificate) or attendance must be obtained for all CE’s. It is each individual AHT’s personal obligation to maintain their CE certificates and all information for submission. Therefore it is MANDATORY to submit CE certificates, with your annual registration, for all of the CE’s that you are claiming, or MAHTA will not be able to issue credits accordingly. If you have a CE credit that does not fit into the above categories, please submit to your MAHTA office for approval at least two weeks before renewal to ensure the Board has sufficient time to examine and approve.
